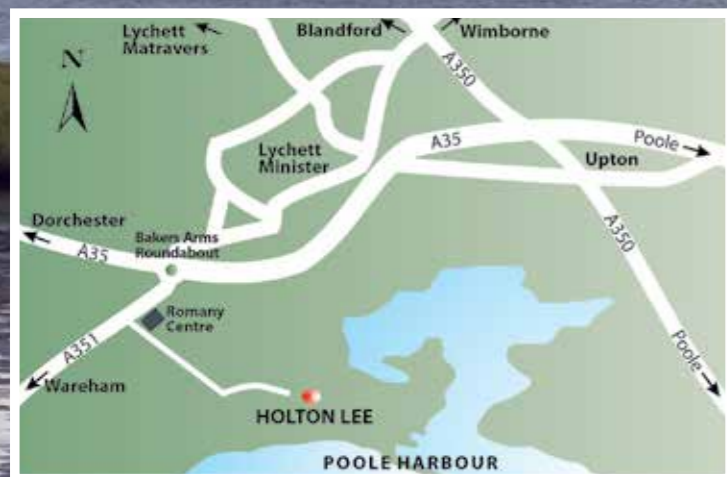
## HOW TO FIND US

Directions to location:

Holton Lee, East Holton, Holton Heath, Poole BH16 6JN

At the Bakers Arms roundabout on the A35 Poole to Dorchester Road turn onto the A351 towards Wareham. About half a mile down the road pass the Romany Works Business Park on your left. Just beyond this is a left turn into Holton Lee. It is signed "Livability at Holton Lee". The cottages are the first buildings you will come to on the left hand side just before a cattle grid.

## ACCOMMODATION

Our accommodation is in Woodland and Gateway, two adjoining cottages in the grounds of Holton Lee. Holidaymakers stay alongside a dedicated and experienced team of volunteers who provide twenty four hour care and support.



Situated between Poole and Wareham Holton Lee overlooks the shores of Poole Harbour and is set in 350 acres of woodland and heathland with large open spaces most of which are wheelchair friendly. It is a rural haven in which you can relax and soak up the atmosphere and hope to see some varied wildlife.



The holidays commence on a Saturday and finish the following Friday. Each group of holidaymakers and carers stay together for the whole week which provides the opportunity to share friendships, companionship and fun.



## ACTIVITIES

On site there are opportunities for bird watching, tractor and trailer rides, carriage driving amongst other things. In the evenings groups can enjoy musical entertainment and BBQs. Off site activities can include a boat trip round Poole Harbour and visits to local attractions such as Swanage Railway, Corfe Castle, Monkey World or the Blue Pool.



## YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

### Do I qualify for a Green Island Trust Holiday?

Holidays are available to all disabled people. Assessments are made on a case by case basis. Priority is given to residents of Dorset and Hampshire.

### Will my disability be suitable for a Green Island Trust holiday?
